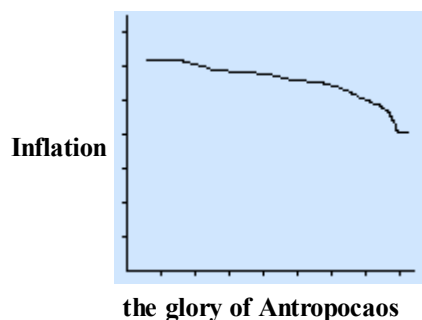
## Social Factors
